

**Department of Licenses and Inspections**  
**Regulation for Amending the Amount Remitted Under Section 1-112 of the Philadelphia Code**

**Adopted** \_\_\_\_\_

The Department of Licenses and Inspections hereby promulgates the following regulation in accordance with Section 8-407 of The Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, Sections A-506 and A-601 of the Philadelphia Administrative Code, and Sections 1-109 and 1-112 of The Philadelphia Code.

**1. Authority**

The Department of Licenses and Inspections has the authority to promulgate such reasonable regulations as appropriate for the exercise of its powers per the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter Section 8-407.

Section 1-112(5) of the Philadelphia Code states a fine of \$75 shall be remitted for a Code Violation Notice unless otherwise specified by another provision of the Code or any regulation.

**2. Applicability and Definitions**

This regulation shall apply to all violation notices, regardless of name/title, that are issued by the Department of Licenses and Inspections pursuant to the procedures set forth in Philadelphia Code Section 1-112.

Site Violation Notice and Code Violation Notice shall be used interchangeably for the purposes of this Regulation.

**3. Remittance Amount**

In lieu of \$75.00, as cited in Philadelphia Code Section 1-112, the amount to be remitted in settlement of a Site Violation Notice shall be fifty percent (50%) of the maximum amount of

the statutory fine pursuant to Philadelphia Code Section 1-109 *et seq.* based on the class of offense set forth in Philadelphia Code Sections A-601.1, A-601.2, and A-601.3.

This section of the regulation does not alter the remittance amounts set forth in Philadelphia Code Section A-506.

### **3. Time to Accept Settlement**

Any person who receives a Site Violation Notice may either appeal said notice or pay the settlement amount within thirty-one (31) days of the date of the notice.
