



Connecting Philadelphia Pre-K–12 Families to Free Internet for Digital Learning

Does your family need consistent internet access? Do you only have access to the internet through a mobile phone?

PHLConnectED may be able to help your household get the internet access it needs so your Pre-K–12 student can connect and learn.



What is PHLConnectED?

PHLConnectED is the City's initiative to help Pre-K–12 families get access to a free, consistent, and reliable internet connection.

Through Summer 2022, eligible students and families will be able to sign up for Comcast's Internet Essentials, or based on need, have access to a free T-Mobile MiFi hotspot.

Who can get connected through PHLConnectED?

Pre-K–12 households may qualify if they:

- Do not have internet access; or
- Have only mobile phone internet access; or
- Are experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity; or
- Have students who participate in remote learning in locations without internet access.

If households already have internet in their homes, they may qualify if they:

- Participate in public benefit programs with income qualifications like Medicaid; or
- Have students designated as English Learners; or
- Have students who receive special education services.
