Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I get the Death Certificate?

An official document with a seal that is issued by the PA Department of Vital Records. The MEO itself does not issue the death certificate. Rather, the death certificate is typically obtained through the Funeral Home or at:

www.MyCertificates.Health.Pa.gov

How can I view my loved one?

Physically viewing your loved one at the MEO is <u>no longer</u> a possibility in our new building. Viewings can be done at the funeral home.

How do I get an autopsy report?

The next of kin can request a copy of the autopsy and toxicology report through the medical records department at the MEO.

Where do I get my loved one's items?

The next of kin is able to pick up their loved one's personal items at the Medical Examiner's Office. To inquire about the personal effects call our medical records department.

Funeral Arrangements

The next of kin will identify a funeral home or cremation service of their choosing and notify our office at 215-685-7445.

The funeral home will then contact our office to have your loved one taken into their care for final arrangements.


