

Woodland Avenue (VA Drwy to 42nd St) Complete Streets Project

Adding high-quality bike/ped infrastructure and landscaping on Woodland Avenue, while calming traffic.

This project will transform Woodland Avenue between the VA Medical Center Driveway and 42nd Street into a safe, multimodal corridor for all users. The project includes:

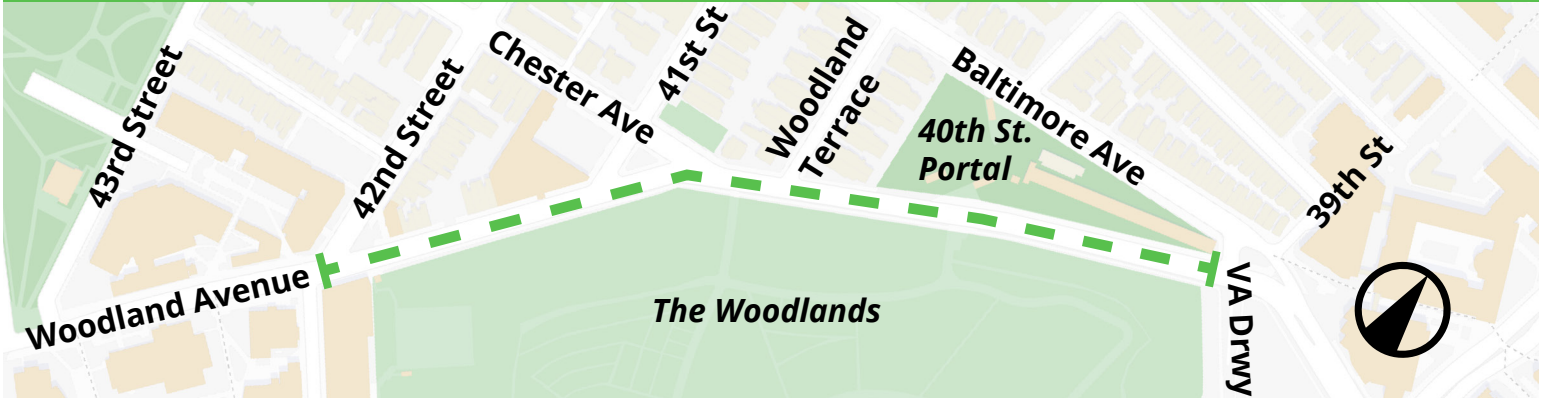
- Two new traffic signals at 40th St. Portal/The Woodlands and at Chester Avenue, with crosswalks
- A two-way raised bikeway on Woodland's south side, next to the historic brick sidewalk
- New trees, landscaping, and street lighting along the whole corridor

There are two phases. The first phase (Short-Term Bike Lane) is scheduled for Fall 2024 completion, and the later Long-Term Bikeway is in design with expected 2027 completion.

Timeline

- **Concept Design/Engagement**
 - 2022 - 2024
- **Short-Term Construction**
 - **Bike Lane:** Summer 2024
 - **Signals & Crosswalks:** Fall 2024
- **Finalize Long-Term Plan**
 - Fall 2025
- **Long-Term Construction**
 - 2027

Map of Project Extents

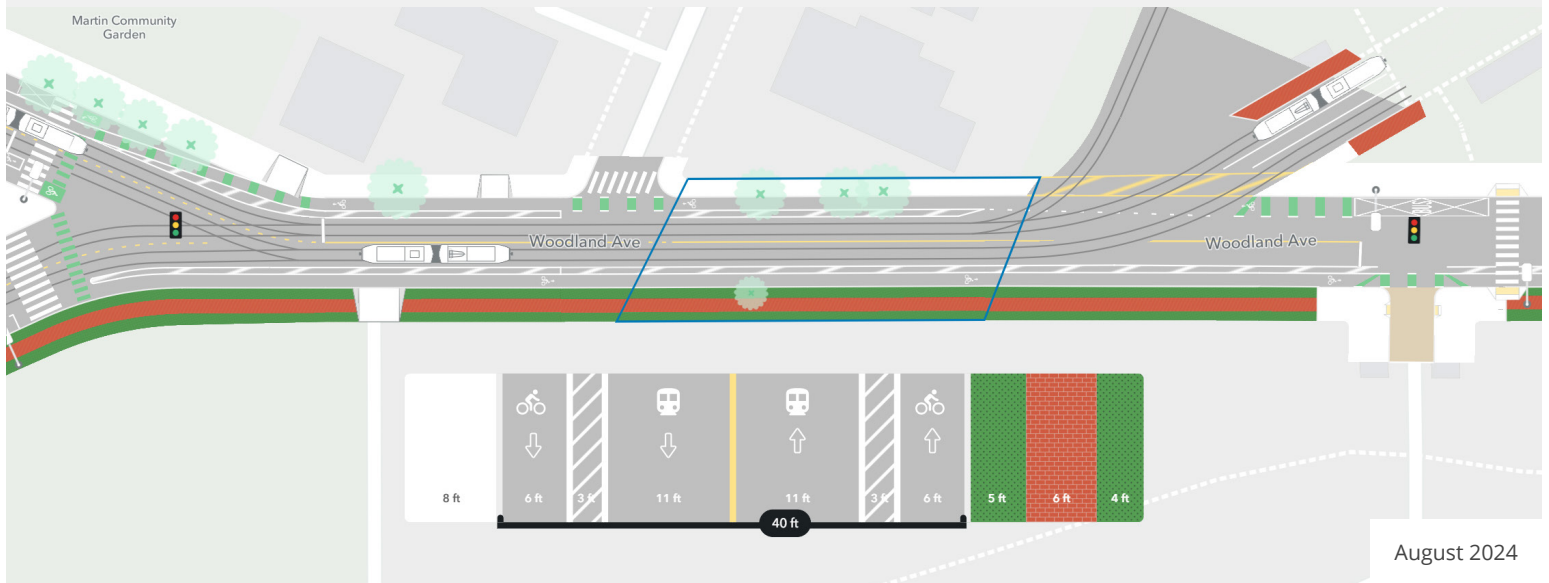

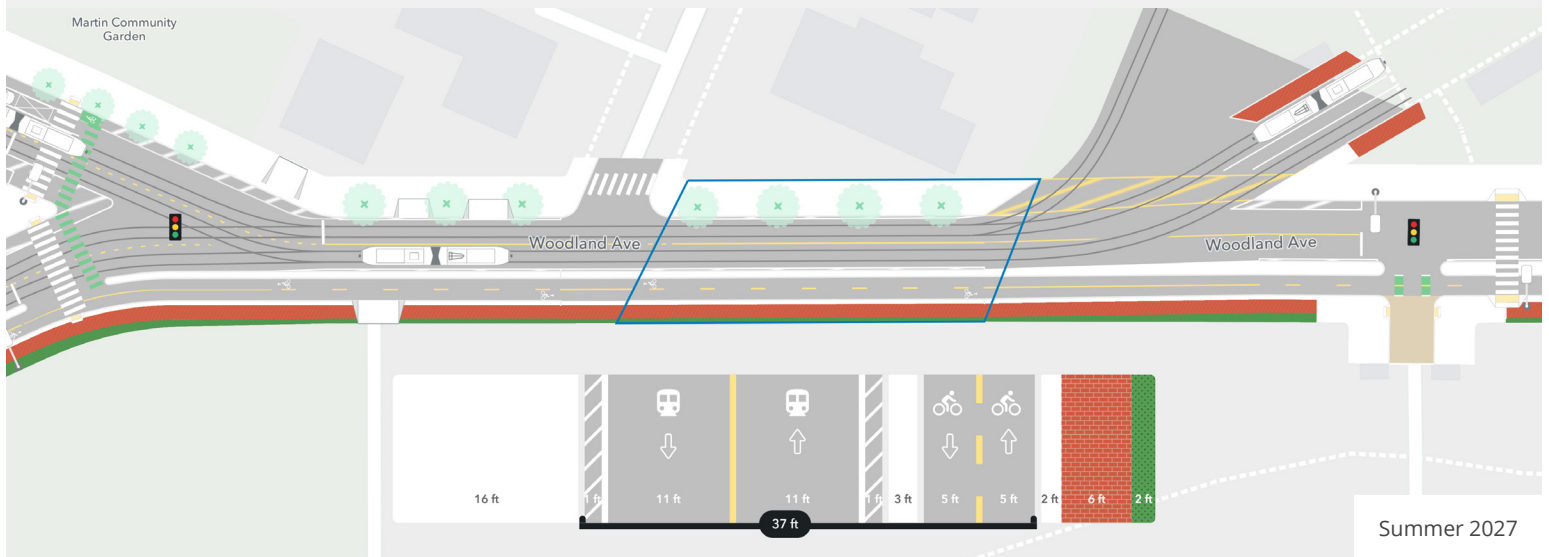
Short-Term Bike Lane Plan (2024)

- Step 1: Separated bike lane created from VA Driveway to Chester Ave along north and south curb
- Step 2: Signals installed with crosswalks at Chester Avenue and 40th Street Portal/The Woodlands



Long-Term Bikeway on South Side Plan (2027)

- Bike lane converted into 2-way raised bikeway on south side of Woodland Avenue, and extended from Chester Ave to 42nd St
- Sidewalk widening and new canopy trees on north side of Woodland Avenue
- Built in coordination with SEPTA Trolley Modernization and The Woodlands
