Good afternoon. As counsel for the owner of the above property, I write to respectfully request a Continuance of the Designation Committee's consideration of the matter currently scheduled for Wednesday November 20th. A continuance will allow the property owner sufficient time to continue to work with the Nominator (the Keeping Society of Philadelphia) and the Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia and discuss the range of options available to protect the historical integrity of the property. **Please note that the Preservation Alliance and the Nominator do not object to this request.**
