

**June 22, 2024: 3600 F Street (OISI: 24-21)**

On June 22, 2024, at approximately 7:50PM, Philadelphia Police Officer Azieme Lindsey and Philadelphia Police Officer Jaime Roman were working in full uniform and in a marked patrol vehicle. They conducted a traffic stop on a Toyota Echo in the 3600 block of F Street. The vehicle was being driven by Ramon Rodriguez Vazquez. Upon investigation, the officers learned that Mr. Vazquez lacked a driver's license, registration, and car insurance. The officers requested a tow truck to "live stop" the car. Mr. Vazquez's girlfriend arrived to remove personal belongings from the vehicle before it was towed.

While items were being removed from the car, Officer Lindsey observed an empty firearm holster inside the vehicle. Mr. Vazquez started running into the street and away from officers, when he turned and fired a firearm three times in the officers' direction. Officer Roman was struck in the neck. Officer Lindsey fired at Mr. Vazquez one time before rendering aid to Officer Roman and transporting him to the hospital. Mr. Vazquez was later arrested on the 800 block of Schiller Street, where he had barricaded himself inside a residence. Officer Roman later succumbed to his injuries.

Ramon Rodriguez Vazquez is a 36-year-old, Latino man.

Officer Lindsey is a 26-year-old Black male. He was assigned to the 25th District and has two years of service.
