- i. Streets <u>Bill 241081</u>: Authorizing encroachments in the nature of a sidewalk cafe in the vicinity of 229 South 45th Street, Philadelphia, PA 19104, under certain terms and conditions. Introduced by Councilmember Gauthier on November 21, 2024.
