



- 84% live or work within the immediate surroundings of Aramingo Avenue (zip code 19125, 19134, 19137)




What do you think about the City's recommendations for safety improvements on Aramingo Avenue?




Do you think the City's recommendations reflect the community input from the survey and public meetings?

Concerns that remain:

- No separation between pedestrians and bicyclists
