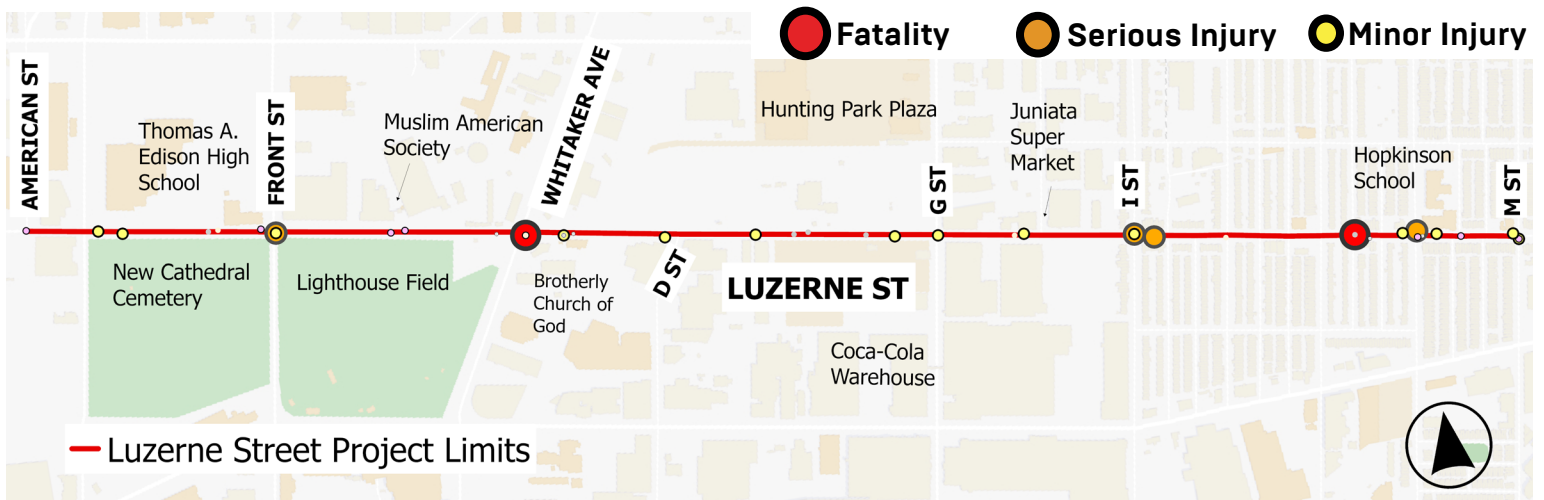

What is Vision Zero?

Vision Zero is a strategy to eliminate all traffic-related deaths and serious injuries, while increasing safety, health, and mobility for all.

From 2019 to 2023, Luzerne Street (American Street to M Street) had

Why Luzerne Street

- It has a history of serious crashes
- It connects residents to jobs, schools, civic institutions, and shopping centers
- It needs quality of life improvements

Engagement Phase 1 - Problem Identification

In Fall 2024, our staff members discussed the project with community members, residents, school staff, students, parents, and businesses along Luzerne Street.

What We've Heard During Phase 1 Engagement



Speeding

Speeding and aggressive driving are common throughout the corridor.



Quality of Life

There is a need for new paving, trees, and better sidewalks (especially in the residential section).



Double Parking & Corner Parking

People frequently double park, which also disrupts the flow of traffic.

Corner parking frequently blocks sightlines at intersections, particularly on small side streets, making them unsafe for pedestrians to cross.

What Would Improve Luzerne St?

We've gathered your feedback and come up with the following ideas. The icons show which issues each idea aims to improve.



Speed Cushions

- Slow down traffic
- Allow emergency vehicles to pass



Raised Crosswalks & Intersections

- Slow down traffic
- Make pedestrians more visible to drivers



Signal Improvements

- Add pedestrian signal
- Make traffic flow better



Concrete Medians/ Ped Refuge Islands

- Shorten crosswalks
- Protect pedestrians from cars that are turning



Curb Extensions

- Shorten crosswalks
- Prevent corner parking and increase visibility



One-way Street & Angled Parking

- Between M St and I St
- Add parking spaces
- Simplify intersections

ADA Ramps

Allow people with disabilities to get on and off sidewalks easily



New Paving

Improves road conditions and evens out the surface

Makes crosswalks and parking areas more visible



Street Trees

Provide shade

Improve the walking experience



Bike Lanes

Improves safety for all road users
