









Q1: How did you hear about the meeting today?



122 people filled out the exit survey




Q2: What is the closest intersection to your home?



118 people answered this question




Q2: What is the closest intersection to your home?






Q3: What is your relation to 47th Street?







Q4: How do you travel on 47th Street?










The City categorized Exit Survey comments into three categories: generally positive, neutral, and generally negative.







Sample comments:

- I appreciate the data-backed efforts to make Philly safer for walkers and bicyclists.
- Traffic calming is needed in our neighborhood for the communities' safety!
- …I have small children and I live in fear of them crossing the streets. Anything to slow traffic and make us all safer!
- I use many modes of transportation and all will be safer with this new layout.





Concerns expressed:

- Requests for all-way stops instead of signals for reduced driver speeds.
- Not enough parking for neighbors
- Maintenance and cleaning of bike lane
- Sight lines in the new layout and conflicts between contraflow bikers and drivers





Table Exercise



At each meeting, we asked attendees to comment directly on Existing/Proposed block diagrams.

Respondent priorities:

- Calm & organize driver behavior at school drop-off and pick-up
- Speed cushions and daylighting setbacks
- Neighborhood & business-serving loading zones






