Dear Philadelphia Art Commission Representative:

On behalf of the Trust for Public Land, AKRF is requesting conceptual approval of schoolyard and stormwater improvements for James Logan Elementary School, located at 1700 Lindley Avenue. We respectfully request this review be placed on the Art Commission meeting agenda for April 9, 2025.

The property encompasses an entire block bound by Lindley Ave to the north, Ogontz Ave to the west, North 17th St to the east, and West Ruscomb St to the south. The existing school building is located in the northern half of the property and surrounded by lawn on its north, west, and east sides. The southern half of the site consists of a paved play yard with basketball courts and the remnants of a fence from a previously removed play structure. The yard is enclosed by existing fence on all sides. No improvements are proposed to the building or the existing lawn areas. The southern half of the site is the subject of the proposed project.

The project proposes school yard improvements to revitalize and improve climate resiliency in a community space. Improvements include play equipment with safety surfacing and seating in the northeastern corner, two basketball courts and one (1) additional paved multi-use sport court in the center, a flexible lawn area in the southeast corner, a quiet seating area in the north, and walking paths throughout the yard. The project also includes green stormwater infrastructure with a rain garden sited along the western perimeter of the yard, a planted swale along the south, and a subsurface stone and pipe system below grade at the basketball courts. Depaving is proposed around the rain garden and swale, and trees are proposed throughout the site. No improvements are anticipated in the easternmost portion of the yard. A fence is proposed running north-south to separate the improvement from the unimproved space.











































 Prefer this play equipment arrangement but needs more space away from building

- Prefer this basketball placement (though Mr. Eli thinks closer to the edge is better for community access)























